Prospective authors should email an abstract and digest of combined length no more than 500 words to: icsat2011@gmail.com. Each submission must contain the title of the paper, name(s) of authors, mailing addresses, telephone and fax numbers and email address of the corresponding author, and must address at least one of the 10 Topics above. Final papers should be no more than six A4 pages in length.
